The American Animal Hospital Association, through which we are accredited, recommends twice-yearly examinations for pets. Pets age faster than their human counterparts. Our veterinarians help you keep your dog healthy throughout their lifetime by these bi-annual visits. By examining them more than once a year, they are more likely to "catch" issues that may go unnoticed. Thorough examinations are one of the most important things veterinarians do for your dog. In them, they look from nose to tail, looking for any issues your pet may have. Catching and treating most issues early can either help to cure them completely or manage them successfully, making your dog healthier and more comfortable throughout his or her life. A blood chemistry and CBC (Complete Blood Count) assist your veterinarian in diagnosing and treating any conditions found before they can become clinical.
