\*\*Heartworm, flea & tick prevention is dispensed according to the weight of the pet. It is, therefore, not included in the total of each visit. Animal Hospital of Statesville recommends that ALL pets stay on heartworm, flea & tick prevention year-round for the health and safety of your pet and your family.

\*\*\*A preferred (and safer), but more expensive rabies vaccine is called Purevax. It is an optional upgrade, at a cost of \$41.50 instead of the \$25.15 rabies vaccine.
